LEE COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS & REGISTRATION Minutes of the December 14, 2021 Board Meeting

The Lee County Board of Elections & Registration held a meeting on December 14, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. in the Elections & Registration Office. Board members present were Mike Sabot, Angus Worthy, Helen Butler, and George Houston. Scott Beeley was unable to attend.

Also in attendance was Veronica Johnson, Director of Elections and Registration.

The meeting was called to order.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

The Board was presented with the minutes from the November 9, 2021 meeting. Mr. Worthy made a **MOTION** to approve the minutes. Mrs. Butler seconded the motion. The motion passed 4-0.

OLD BUSINESS:

Discussion was held on the reapportionment process. The Board of Education voted on December 13, 2021 to select Map #5 for district lines moving forward. The County Commissioners are slated to vote on a map at their December 14, 2021meeting. The General Assembly has passed Congressional, Senate, and House districts.

Discussion was held on preparations for the 2022 election cycle. Qualifying fees have been set by the state, and local qualifying fees will be published in the Lee County Ledger in early January.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Board was presented with current financial statements for review.

The Board was presented with current voter registration reports. As of December 13, 2021 Lee County had 22,706 active registered voters.

The Board was informed Mr. Frank Griffin has been appointed to the Georgia Board of Education, and has resigned from the local Board of Education, District 5. A special election will be held in conjunction with the May 24, 2022 Primary/Nonpartsian Election. Mrs. Johnson will work with the Board of Education coordinate issuing a call for the Special Election.

Mrs. Johnson informed the Board she will be attending a Director's Meeting with staff from the Secretary of State's office on December 15, 2021 in Atlanta.
