MEETING MINUTES

1. CALL TO ORDER

The Lee County Utilities Authority met for their regular scheduled meeting on June 15, 2023. The meeting was held in the Opal Cannon Auditorium of the Page Tharp Governmental building in Leesburg, Georgia. A. Authority Customer Private Well Use

Chris Boswell advised the Board that SB121 might affect the existing Authority policy pertaining to the well use within the Authority's service area. He advised that Jimmy Skipper, attorney for the Authority, had reviewed the bill and recommends the attached resolution for consideration to strengthen and clarify the Authority's current policy.

Johnny Barthlein made a motion to adopt the resolution titled "A RESOLUTION TO AMEND ARTICLE I, SECTION 4(A) OF THE LEE COUNTY UTILITIES AUTHORITY WATER AND SEWER REGULATIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR REOUIREMENTS WITH RESPECT TO WATER CONNECTIONS TO THE LEE COUNTY UTILITIES AUTHORITY WATER SYSTEM; TO PROVIDE FOR EXCEPTIONS TO SUCH CONNECTION REQUIREMENTS WITH RESPECT TO SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY OWNERS AND FARMS; TO PROHIBIT EXISTING CUSTOMERS OF THE AUTHORITY'S WATER SYSTEM FROM TAKING ACTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DISCONNECTING SUCH CUSTOMER'S PREMISES FROM THE AUTHORITY'S WATER SYSTEM; TO PROVIDE FOR THE INSTALLATION OF WATER WELLS FOR LANDSCAPE IRRIGATION, RECREATIONAL USE OR PROCESS USE FOR FARMS, COMMERCIAL, OR INDUSTRIAL AUTHORITY WATER CUSTOMERS OWNING MORE THAN TEN (10) ACRES OF LAND; TO PROHIBIT COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL EXISTING AUTHORITY CUSTOMERS FROM INSTALLING WATER WELLS FOR LANDSCAPE IRRIGATION, RECREATIONAL USE, OR PROCESS USE IRRIGATION ON PROPERTY LESS THAN TEN (10) ACRES; TO PROVIDE FOR SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY OWNERS AND FARMS OVER TEN (10) ACRES; TO UTILIZE WATER WELLS FOR LANDSCAPE IRRIGATION, RECREATION USE OR PROCESS USE: TO PROHIBIT SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY OWNERS AND FARMS FROM INSTALLING WATER WELLS FOR LANDSCAPE IRRIGATION, RESIDENTIAL USE, OR PROCESS USE ON PROPERTY LESS THAN TEN (10) ACRES; TO PROVIDE FOR RESCISION OF EXISTING PROVISIONS OF THE LEE COUNTY UTILITIES AUTHORITY WATER AND SEWER REGULATIONS IN CONFLICT WITH THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES", Amy Addison seconded the motion. . Voting yea were Levent Gokcen, Victor Stubbs, Amy Addison and Johnny Barthlein. Art Ford opposed the motion. The motion passed four to one.
