### A. H. M. G. P. 4400-0033 LCUA Generator Project Discussion

Chris Boswell advised the Board that the Authority has received the official signed "Get Started Letter" on July 8, 2025. The Authority applied for the emergency grant for generators in 2019. The prices that are listed in the application are from 2019 and are expected to be outdated. The funding is FEMA share \$559,340, State Share \$74,579, and the local share of \$111,868. The project is to be paid by the authority and reimbursed by FEMA and the State after expenses are paid.

After the discussion of the project, Art Ford motioned to confirm the timeframe for reimbursement and to proceed with bidding out the project in two separate proposals, one for the generators and one for installation.
